# The Little Bear Saved By *Healing Light* ©

## South Dakota Doctor's Invention Saves Cub Bear's Life

This is not a nursery rhyme story about Poppa Bear, Momma Bear and Baby Bear, but a true story about Baby Bear who had a tragic accident...but a very happy ending!

**Baby Bear**, a black bear cub, was found unable to move at the base of a large oak tree in Minnesota by landowner Gary Mathis. An officer from the Department of Natural Resources recommended that Baby Bear be destroyed. A veterinarian was consulted and his report was grim saying that if Baby Bear had broken his back in the fall from the tree, surgery was not an option.

Under “normal” circumstances, Baby Bear’s life would have tragically ended at that point – which I think you would agree is not much of an ending for a “Baby Bear” story.



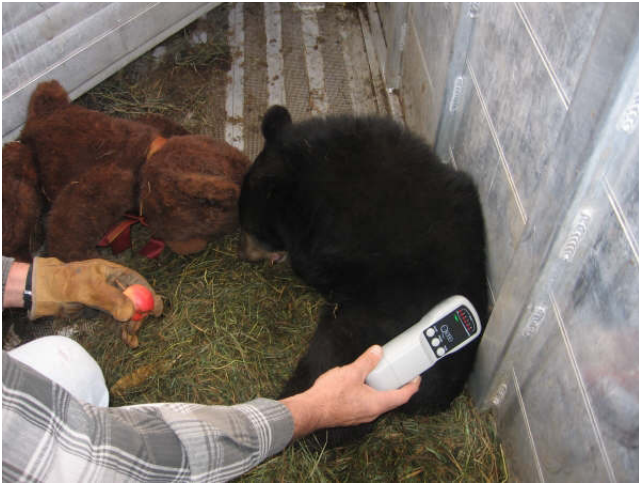
Mathis remembered his chiropractor, Dr Steve Keogh, had successfully treated his painful back with a veterinary laser.

He called Dr Keogh to see if he would treat Baby Bear. He said his license didn't allow him to treat animals, but his wife Donna and his daughter, both had experience using the Q1000 Laser System on themselves for everything from sprains to headaches and maybe they could help Baby Bear.
